Window Dressing Safety Bulletin

New HV and PPE policy

Demonstrating our continued commitment to eliminating corporate risk, Window Dressing PLC is implementing a new HV and PPE policy.

From 1st December 2012, PTS holders are required to wear **full body armour** when on or near the line, together with a genital pelmet and ornamental snood. The armour must be -

- Pantone 165C in colour but not so garish as to offend Great Crested Newts or bats
- compliant with Disability Rights, Sexual Equality, Noise Abatement and Waste Disposal regulations
- flange lubricated to prevent chafing
- cleaned with AluBright Deoxidizing Lacquer and re-buffed before the start of each shift
- fitted with bluetooth, GPS and paper filing facilities, together with forward and rear-facing cameras
- self-supporting in case the wearer enters a state of torpor during the monthly safety brief
- capable of withstanding a damn good talking to.

When working on or near an electrified line, a Faraday's Cage must also be worn.

For emergency protection, the new MkIV Short-Circuiting Lance (UR4/IT) must be carried in third-rail areas, as well as on lines passing through CHAV¹ and PIKEY² hotspots.
